The City of Peterborough, Gunthorpe Road, Newborough, Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (Temporary Restriction of Through Traffic) Notice 26-339 2026 Ref: 26-339

The effect of which is to stop any vehicle from proceeding along the road known as Gunthorpe Road, Newborough, at its junction with Paston Parkway for approximately 100m, Northbound only.
