U109 WEST END ROAD TWEEDMOUTH

(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council intends to make an Order to prohibit the use by vehicular traffic on that section of the U109 West End Road Tweedmouth from its junction with Ord Drive in a northerly direction for a distance of 21 metres in the County of Northumberland.

The Order is to be effective from the 22nd June 2026 until the 1st October 2026. It is expected that the road will only be closed from the 22nd June 2026 until the 31st July 2026 and that the road will be closed at all times during this period; however, the order will remain in place until 1st October 2026.

An alternative route will be available for use whilst the TTRO is in force being Blakewell Road, Main Street, Prince Edward Road, Ord Drive, and vice-versa and should the need arise changes may be made to the alternative routes, where possible these changes will be signposted accordingly.

C20 MINDRUM MILL JUNCTION TO CORNHILL JUNCTION

CORNHILL ON TWEED

(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council have made an Order to prohibit the use by vehicular traffic on that section of the C20 Mindrum Mill Junction to Cornhill Junction from its junction with C21 West Learmouth Junction to Bareless Junction heading in a northwards direction for a distance of 2050 metres in the County of Northumberland.

The Order is to be effective from the 1st June 2026 until the 12th June 2026.

It is expected that the road will only be closed from the 1st June 2026 until the 5th June 2026 between the hours of 09:00 and 15:30 during this period; however, the order will remain in place until 12th June 2026.

(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council have made an Order to prohibit the use by vehicular traffic on that section of the U1014 Kypie Hill Junction to Flodden Edge Junction Mindrum from its junction with B6352 County Boundary to West Flodden heading in a northerly direction for a distance of 475 metres in the County of Northumberland.

The Order is to be effective from the 3rd June 2026 until the 12th June 2026.

B6347 CHARLTON MIRES TO DOXFORD NEWHOUSES

(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council have made an Order to prohibit the use of vehicular traffic on the following section of road and to hereby bring into force a speed restriction on the following section of roads in the County of Northumberland.

The Order is to be effective from the 8th June 2026 until the 8th November 2026.

Road Closure:

B6347 Charlton Mires to Doxford Newhouses

A road closure will be in place which will prohibit the use of vehicular traffic on the following section of road:

B6347 Charlton Mires to Doxford Newhouses from its junction with the A1 heading in a easterly direction for a length of 742 metres, continuing on in a northerly direction for a length of 1094 metres.

It is expected that the road will only be closed on the following dates:

- Civils – 8th June 2026 until the 3rd July 2026 between the hours of 08:00 until 17:00
- Surfacing – 6th July 2026 until the 10th July 2026 between the hours of 08:00 until 17:00

An alternative route will be available for use whilst the TTRO is in force being B6347, A1, U203, C69, and vice-versa and should the need arise changes may be made to the alternative routes, where possible these changes will be signposted accordingly.

Speed Restriction: (60mph down to 40mph)

A speed restriction will hereby further be in force which will restrict the speed of all vehicular traffic from 60mph down to 40mph and no person shall drive their vehicle in excess of 40 mph on the B6347 Charlton Mires to Doxford Newhouses from its junction with the A1 heading in a easterly direction for a length of 742 metres, continuing on in a northerly direction for a length of 1094 metres in the County of Northumberland.

The speed restriction will be in force between the hours of 17:00 and 08:00 on the following dates in order to protect the carriageway surface outside of working hours.

- Civils – 8th June 2026 until the 3rd July 2026 between the hours of 17:00 until 08:00
- Surfacing – 6th July 2026 until the 10th July 2026 between the hours of 17:00 until 08:00
