(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2026

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 16A

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council (“the Council”), in exercise of its powers as the local traffic authority under section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and all other enabling powers, has on the 15 May 2026 made the Northumberland County Council Newcastle Half Marathon & 10k 2026 Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026 (“the TTRO”).

The Council has made the TTRO for the purposes of facilitating the holding of Newcastle Half Marathon & 10k 2026 (“the Event”) by prohibiting traffic on the C356 Berwick Hill from its junction with the C368 Seaton Burn roundabout New Kennels junction in a westerly direction for a length of 3,200 metres and the C368 Seaton Burn roundabout New Kennels junction from its junction with the C366 Blagdon junction to Plessey North Moor Farm junction in a southerly direction for a length of 2,100 metres (“the Road”).

The TTRO shall come into force at **08:30 hours on 12 July 2026** and will remain in force until **11:30 hours on 12 July 2026**, subject to the provisions of section 16B of the Act.

An alternative route will be available for use whilst the TTRO is in force being For the A1 northbound and the A19 via the A1068, the C366 and vice versa. For Ponteland, Newcastle and A1 southbound via the A696, the C358, the C356 and vice versa. Should the need arise changes may be made to the alternative routes, where possible these changes will be signposted accordingly.

All restrictions on the Road will be sign-posted and staffed and will remain in force only for as long as is necessary.

Nothing in the TTRO shall apply to:

- Any activities taking place on the Road related to the organisation and holding of the Event;
- Anything done with the permission of, or at the direction of, a police officer or a Duly Authorised Officer of the Council.
- Any vehicle being used by, or for the purposes of, the emergency services;
- Any vehicle being used by or for the purposes of a statutory undertaker (e.g. the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which requires vehicles to be brought onto the Road); or
- Pedestrian access to any premises adjoining the Road.
