

## EAST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

#### The East Sussex (Public Footpath Framfield 65a and Uckfield 38) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2024

To protect public safety during a housing development, the Secretary of State has extended the above East Sussex County Council's Order made on 21 June 2024 under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following footpaths:

##### Temporary Footpath Closure

The whole of **Public Footpath Framfield 65a** will be closed to all users between TQ 4830 1954 and TQ 4832 1960.

The whole of **Public Footpath Uckfield 38** will be closed to all users between TQ 4824 1934 and TQ 4830 1954.

Unfortunately, there is no alternative route.

The closure will be in force for 18 months from 1 July 2026, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the footpaths still be unavailable to use.

#### The East Sussex (Public Footpath Wartling 23 (part)) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2026

To protect public safety while part of Wartling 23 that is an existing access track is upgraded to facilitate the development of an approved battery energy storage system (BESS) facility, along with some of the initial BESS site itself, under planning reference 'WD/2023/2940/MAJ' as approved under condition discharge 'WD/2025/2358/CD', East Sussex County Council have made an Order under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following footpath:

##### Temporary Footpath Closure

Part of **Public Footpath Wartling 23** will be closed to all users between TQ 6689 1136 (Boreham Hill) and TQ 6698 1120 for a distance of 190 metres. Unfortunately, there is no alternative route.

The closure will be in force for 6 months from 29 June 2026, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the footpath still be unavailable to use.

To protect public safety during surface and drainage improvements, East Sussex County Council intend not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following bridleways:

##### Temporary Bridleway Closure

The whole of **Public Bridleway Alfriston 12a** will be closed to all users between TQ 5168 0298 and TQ 5154 0295 for a distance of 140 metres.

The whole of **Public Bridleway Alfriston 12b** will be closed to all users between TQ 5154 0295 and TQ 5105 0345 for a distance of 725 metres.

The whole of **Public Bridleway Alfriston 32b** will be closed to all users between TQ 5152 0310 and TQ 5154 0295 for a distance of 155 metres.

An alternative route will be available along The Broadway, and bridleways Alfriston 33, Alfriston 32a, Alfriston 14b and Alfriston 14c and vice versa.

The closure will be in force for 6 months from 13 July 2026, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the bridleways still be unavailable to use.

#### The East Sussex (U7663 Common Lane, Laughton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2026

##### Temporary Road Closure

**Old Swan Lane** – from the junction with C411 Station Road to the junction with U7076 White Dyke.

To allow Openreach to carry out works, East Sussex County Council have made an Order under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following lengths of road;

##### Temporary Road Closures

**Bradfords Lane** – from the junction with A22 Uckfield bypass to the junction with U7518 Bradfords Lane.

**Layby Old A22** – from the junction with U7403 Bradfords Lane to the junction with A22 Uckfield bypass.

A safe route will be provided for pedestrians and vehicular access for residents and to properties maintained whenever possible with an alternative route for through traffic via U7518 Bradfords Lane – A26 Lewes Road – A22 Little Horsted roundabout, Uckfield bypass and vice versa.

#### THE EAST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY HAMSEY 33) DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2026

The above Order, made on 10 April 2026, was confirmed by East Sussex County Council without modifications on 19 June 2026 and took effect from that date. The confirmed Order modifies the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding a public bridleway as follows:

A public bridleway with an arbitrary centreline route shown on the Order Plan between points D-C-H-B.

Commencing at a gate at the junction of public bridleways Hamsey 20b, Hamsey 20c and Hamsey 31e, at point D at TQ 3935 1130, with a width of 3 metres.

Continuing from point D in a north-westerly direction for 25 metres on a grass track in between boundary fences, with a width of 3 metres, to point C at TQ 3932 1131.

The bridleway continues from point C in a westerly direction for 88 metres on a grass track in between boundary fences, with a width of 3 metres, to point H at TQ 3923 1129.

Continuing from point H in a west north-westerly direction for 94 metres on a grass track, with a width of 3 metres, to the junction of public bridleways Hamsey 32a and Hamsey 32b, at point B at TQ 3915 1131.

The width of the public bridleway will be 3 metres throughout.
