Notice is hereby given that North Lanarkshire Council propose to consider the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which will be to amend the North Lanarkshire Council (Various Streets, North Lanarkshire) (Waiting and Loading Restrictions – Phase 3) Order 2023 as detailed below.

Banton

Lammerknowes Road

From the extended southeast kerbline of Mailings Road south-eastwards for a distance of 16 metres, or thereby.

North-East

From the extended southeast kerbline of Mailings Road south-eastwards for a distance of 11 metres, or thereby.

South-West

Mailings Road

From a point of 10 metres southwest of the extended southwest kerbline of Lammerknowes Road to a point 10 metres northeast of the extended northeast kerbline of Lammerknowes Road, a distance of 27 metres or thereby.
