U9549 HALL CLOSE DALE FOOTWAY CRAMLINGTON

(TEMPORARY FOOTWAY CLOSURE) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council intends to make an Order to prohibit the use by pedestrian traffic on that section of the U9549 Hall Close Dale Footway Cramlington from outside the rear of number 9 Doddington Drive heading in a southerly direction for a length of 27 metres in the County of Northumberland.

The Order is to be effective from the 3rd August 2026 until the 21st August 2026.

It is expected that the footway will only be closed from the 3rd August 2026 until the 7th August 2026 during this period; however, the order will remain in place until 21st August 2026.

An alternative route will be available for use whilst the TTRO is in force being from the gable end of number 11 Doddington Drive heading in a southerly direction to the gable end of number 1 Doddington Drive, then continuing around the rear of number 1 Doddington drive heading in a northerly direction to outside number 5 Doddington Drive and should the need arise changes may be made to the alternative routes, where possible these changes will be signposted accordingly.

U9709 HATHERY LANE HORTON

(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council intends to make an Order to prohibit the use by vehicular traffic on that section of the U9709 Hathery Lane Horton from its junction with Bebside Road for a distance of 2460 metres in a south-easterly then south-westerly direction in the County of Northumberland.
