(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council intends to make an Order to prohibit the use by vehicular traffic on the following sections in the County of Northumberland:

U9503 Waterloo Road Back Lane from its junction with Church Street for a distance of 123 metres in a south-westerly direction

U9503 Wanley Street from its junction with Waterloo Road Back Lane for a distance of 21 metres in a south-easterly direction.

The Order is to be effective from the 20th August 2026 until the 27th August 2026.

U9549 HALL CLOSE DALE FOOTWAY CRAMLINGTON

(TEMPORARY FOOTWAY CLOSURE) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council have made an Order to prohibit the use by pedestrian traffic on that section of the U9549 Hall Close Dale Footway Cramlington from outside the rear of number 9 Doddington Drive heading in a southerly direction for a length of 27 metres in the County of Northumberland.

The Order is to be effective from the 3rd August 2026 until the 21st August 2026.
