Walker Avenue

North side - from the point where the extended northern kerbline of Lescar Road, meets the extended eastern kerbline of Stephenson Vway for a distance of 13 metres in an easterly direction.

South side - from the point where the extended southern kerbline of Lescar Road, meets the extended eastern kerbline of Stephenson Vway for a distance of 38 metres in an easterly direction.

Stephenson Way

Both sides from the point 40m south of where the extended southern kerbline of Lescar Road, meets the extended eastern kerbline of Stephenson Way for a distance of 133 metres in an northerly direction (until its junction with Walker Avenue).

Exemptions will apply to the no waiting at any time restrictions to enable a vehicle to wait for passengers to board or alight, for disabled badge holders, for loading and unloading of goods, for enabling work to be carried out in or adjacent to the road and for emergency service vehicles.
