NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ESTABLISH A NEW ZEBRA CROSSING AND TO CONSTRUCT A ROAD HUMP A586 TALBOT ROAD, SOUTH WEST OF THE ACCESS TO SAINSBURY'S CAR PARK TRAFFIC REGULATION NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Blackpool Borough Council ("the Council"), in exercise of its powers under section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and sections 90A and 90C of the Highways Act 1980, proposes to establish a zebra pedestrian crossing on a raised table/road hump at A586 Talbot Road, South West of the access to Sainsbury's Car Park, Blackpool. The effect of the proposed humped zebra crossing will be to:

- avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising; and
- facilitate the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).

Zebra Crossing

The new pedestrian zebra crossing is proposed to be established on A586 Talbot Road, South West of the access to Sainsbury's Car Park, Blackpool, the location of the zebra crossing being described below:

Talbot Road, 31.2m south-west of the Sainsbury's car park access mini roundabout to the centre of the zebra crossing.

The design of the zebra crossing includes the provision of white zig-zag road markings on both sides of it. No parking or waiting would be permitted within the areas marked by white zig-zags.

Road Hump

The proposed road hump is to be constructed on A586 Talbot Road, South West of the access to Sainsbury's Car Park, Blackpool, as described below:

- a 75 mm high, kerb to kerb flat top road hump with a plateau length of 6 metres and approach ramps at a gradient of 1:15 constructed on A586 Talbot Road, the centre of the road hump at a point 31.2 metres South West of the access to Sainsbury's Car Park, Blackpool.

As specified in the following Schedules.

SCHEDULE 1

Type and dimensions of road hump

- Longitudinal profile: Flat-topped
- Transverse profile: Kerb-to-kerb
- Height: 75mm
- Plateau length: 6 metres
- Length (in plan) of on/off ramps: 1.125 metre
- Overall length (plateau plus ramps): 8.25 metres
- On/off ramp gradient: 1:15

SCHEDULE 2

Location of road hump (distance measured to centre of road hump)

Street	Extent
Talbot Road	31.2 metres south west of the access to Sainsbury's Car Park, Blackpool on A586 Talbot Road

SCHEDULE 3

Limits of crossing (length of black and white stripes)

Street	Extent
Talbot Road	From the centre of the road hump (refer to Schedule 2) for a distance of 1.6 metres in a north easterly and south westerly direction.

SCHEDULE 4

Limits of zebra controlled area (edge of black and white stripes to end of white zig-zag line)

Street	Extent
Talbot Road	Both sides and centre of the carriageway from a point 1.6 metres north east of the centre of the road hump, for a distance of 16.15m in a north-easterly direction.
Talbot Road	North-west side and centre of the carriageway from a point 1.6 metres south – west of the centre of the road hump, for a distance of 20.41m in a south-westerly direction.
Talbot Road	South-east side and centre of the carriageway from a point 1.6 metres south – west of the centre of the road hump, for a distance of 7.63m in a south-westerly direction.

A copy of the notice, plan showing the location of the proposed zebra crossing and road hump and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to establish the crossing and construct the road hump may be inspected at Customer First, Municipal Buildings, Corporation Street, Blackpool, FY1 1NF and the Council's offices at Number 1 Bickerstaffe Square, Talbot Road, Blackpool, FY1 3AH during their normal opening hours.

Any objections and representations relating to the proposed Notice, proposed crossing and/or proposed road hump must be made in writing stating the grounds for any objection and should be sent to either;
