

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)
A697 NEWTOWN JUNCTION TO
HIGH LEARCHILD JUNCTION
(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026**
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council intends to make an Order to prohibit the use of vehicular traffic on the following section of road and to hereby bring into force a speed restriction on the following section of roads in the County of Northumberland.

The Order is to be effective from the 1st September 2026 until the 27th December 2026
Road Closure:

A697 Newtown Junction to High Leachchild Junction
A road closure will be in place which will prohibit the use of vehicular traffic on the following section of road:- A697 Newtown Junction to High Leachchild Junction 210 metres south of its junction with U4092 continuing on for a further 410 metres.

It is expected that the road will only be closed from the 1st September 2026 until the 19th September 2026 however it will be closed at all times during this period; however, the order will remain in place until 27th December 2026.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via the A697, B6341, C90 and vice versa and should the need arise changes may be made to the alternative routes, where possible these changes will be signposted accordingly.

Speed Restriction:- (60mph down to 40mph)
A speed restriction will hereby further be in force which will restrict the speed of all vehicular traffic from 60 mph down to 40mph and no person shall drive their vehicle in excess of 40 mph on the A697 Newtown Junction to High Leachchild Junction 210 metres south of its junction with U4092 continuing on for a further 410 metres in the County of Northumberland.

The speed restriction will be in force at all times being the 20th September 2026 until the 27th December 2026 or at any point when the road is safe to be reopened. This is to protect the surface of the carriageway and for safety whilst the works are being carried out.
