

(BANKWOOD WAY/WOODHEAD ROAD, BIRSTALL, BATLEY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Kirklees by reason of works proposed to be carried out on or near the road intends not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order the effect of which will be that no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in that length of Bankwood Way/Woodhead Road, Birstall from its junction with Gelderd Road to its junction with Showcase/Nando's/McDonalds entrance **PROVIDED THAT** such prohibition shall not extend to vehicles being used in connection with the works to be carried out on or near the closed length of road or to vehicles requiring access up to the point(s) of the closure.
Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the closure will be available via the unaffected length of Bankwood Way, Gelderd Road and vice versa.

It is intended that the closure will commence on Tuesday, 1 September 2026 and remain in force until 10 September 2026 between 23:00 hours to 07:00 hours only (although it can remain in force for any period up to 18 months if necessary).

(ELM WAY, BIRSTALL, BATLEY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Kirklees by reason of works proposed to be carried out on or near the road intends not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order the effect of which will be that no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in that length of Elm Way, Birstall, Batley from its junction with Moat Hill to a point outside property no. 23 **PROVIDED THAT** such prohibition shall not extend to vehicles being used in connection with the works to be carried out on or near the closed length of road or to vehicles requiring access up to the point(s) of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the closure will be available via Moat Hill, Ashfield Road, Elm Way.

It is intended that the closure will commence on Tuesday, 1 September 2026 and remain in force until 3 September 2026 between 08:00 hours to 17:00 hours each day (although it can remain in force for any period up to 18 months if necessary).

(TRINITY STREET, BATLEY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Kirklees by reason of works proposed to be carried out on or near the road has made an Order the effect of which will be that no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in that length of Trinity Street, Batley from a point to the side of property no. 42 to its junction with Upper Road **PROVIDED THAT** such prohibition shall not extend to vehicles being used in connection with the works to be carried out on or near the closed length of road or to vehicles requiring access up to the point(s) of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the closure will be available via the unaffected length of Trinity Street, Wilson Wood Street, Hyrstlands Road, Town Street, Upper Road.

It is intended that the closure will commence on Monday, 17 August 2026 and remain in force until 4 September 2026 (although it can remain in force for any period up to 18 months if necessary).

(WELLHOUSE LANE, MIRFIELD)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Kirklees by reason of works proposed to be carried out on or near the road has made an Order the effect of which will be that no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in that short length of Wellhouse Lane, Mirfield at its junction with Flash Lane **PROVIDED THAT** such prohibition shall not extend to vehicles being used in connection with the works to be carried out on or near the closed length of road or to vehicles requiring access up to the point(s) of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the closure will be available via the following routes:-

Clockwise - Flash Lane, Dunbottle Lane, Greenside Road, Jenny Lane, Wellhouse Lane.

Anti-clockwise - Flash Lane, Hepworth Lane.

It is intended that the closure will commence on Wednesday, 19 August 2026 and remain in force up to 25 August 2026 between 08:00 hours to 18:00 hours only (although it can remain in force for any period up to 18 months if necessary).

(WOOD STREET, CRACKENEDGE, BATLEY CARR, DEWSBURY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Kirklees by reason of works proposed to be carried out on or near the road has made an Order the effect of which will be that no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in that length of Wood Street, Crackenedge, Batley Carr from a point outside property no. 1 for approximately 15 metres **PROVIDED THAT** such prohibition shall not extend to vehicles being used in connection with the works to be carried out on or near the closed length of road or to vehicles requiring access up to the point(s) of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

There is no alternative diversionary route available.

It is intended that the closure will operate on Thursday, 20 August 2026 only (although it can remain in force for any period up to 18 months if necessary).

(SPEN BANK, CLECKHEATON)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Kirklees by reason of works proposed to be carried out on or near the road has made an Order the effect of which will be that no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in that length of Spen Bank, Cleckheaton from a point outside property no. 108 to a point outside property no. 112 **PROVIDED THAT** such prohibition shall not extend to vehicles being used in connection with the works to be carried out on or near the closed length of road or to vehicles requiring access up to the point(s) of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the closure will be available via the unaffected length of Spen Bank, St Peg Lane, Dewsbury Road, Bradford Road, Leeds Road, Oxford Road, Spen Lane.

It is intended that the closure will commence on Monday, 17 August 2026 and remain in force until 21s August 2026 between 08:00 hours to 17:00 hours only (although it can remain in force for any period up to 18 months if necessary).

(PENTLAND ROAD, SAVILE TOWN, DEWSBURY)

It is intended that the closure will commence on Monday, 17 August 2026 and remain in force until 19 August 2026 between 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours only (although it can remain in force for any period up to 18 months if necessary).
