The City of Peterborough Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic Order 2026 – Oundle Road, Wittering

The effect of which is to stop any vehicle from proceeding along the road known as Oundle Road, Wittering, at Bone Mill Farm. The Council is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited due to proposed works being executed on the above road. The alternative route for vehicles affected by this order is: Old Oundle Road, A47, A1, Townsend Road and vice versa. The proposed order will come into force on the 24/08/2026 and will continue until the meter exchange works have been completed or until the 23/08/2027, whichever is the earlier. The City of Peterborough Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic Order 2026 – Waterworks Lane
