A190 STATION ROAD SEGHELL A190 MAIN STREET SEGHELL

(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council intends to make an Order to prohibit the use by vehicular traffic on the following sections of roads in the County of Northumberland:

- A190 Station Road from its junction with U9539 East View West View, Seghill in a south-westerly direction for a length of 185 metres.
- A190 Main Street from its junction with A190 Backworth Lane Roundabout, Seghill in a north-easterly direction in its entirety.

The Order is to be effective from the 14th September 2026 until the 14th March 2027.

It is expected that the road will only be closed from the 14th September 2026 until the 19th September 2026 between the hours of 20:00 and 06:00 during this period; however, the order will remain in place until 14th March 2027.

FOOTWAY BETWEEN 8 AND 10 CEDAR CLOSE BEDLINGTON (TEMPORARY FOOTWAY CLOSURE) ORDER 2026
