A697 AKELD TO MILFIELD

A697 COTTAGE ROAD TO AKELD WOOLER (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council intends to make an Order to prohibit the use by vehicular traffic on the following sections in the County of Northumberland.

- A697 Akeld to Milfield from its junction with the C35 heading in a southerly direction for a length of 4140 metres.
- A697 Cottage Road to Akeld from its point with Akeld to Millfield heading in a easterly direction for a length of 1200 metres.

U107 WALKERGATE BERWICK UPON TWEED

(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2026

U107 PALACE STREET BERWICK UPON TWEED

(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2026
