A1068 ELLINGTON TO WIDDRINGTON,
WIDDRINGTON VILLAGE
(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council intends to make an Order to prohibit the use by vehicular traffic on that section of the A1068 Ellington to Widdrington from its junction with the B1337 Mile Road to Houndalee Junction in a northerly direction for a length of 800 metres in the County of Northumberland. (TEMPORARY FOOTWAY CLOSURE) ORDER 2026

C172 GREENSIDE BANK TO HARBOTTLE
(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council have made an Order to prohibit the use of vehicular traffic and to hereby bring into force a speed restriction on that section of the road C172 Greenside Bank to Harbottle from its junction with U4029 heading in a westerly direction for a length of 712 metres in the County of Northumberland.

The Order is to be effective from the 21st September 2026 until the 21st February 2027.

Road Closure: C172 Greenside Bank to Harbottle.

A road closure will be in place which will prohibit the use of vehicular traffic on the following section of road:

C172 Greenside Bank to Harbottle from its junction with U4029 heading in a westerly direction for a length of 712 metres.

It is expected that the road will only be closed on the following dates:

- Civils – 21st September 2026 until the 10th October 2026 between the hours of 08:00 until 17:00.
- Resurfacing – 16th November 2026 until the 18th November 2026 between the hours of 08:00 until 17:00.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via the C172, C176, C178 and vice versa during this period; however, the order will remain in place until 21st February 2027.

Speed Restriction:- (60mph down to 40mph)

A speed restriction will hereby further be in force which will restrict the speed of all vehicular traffic from 60mph down to 40mph and no person shall drive their vehicle in excess of 40 mph on the C172 Greenside Bank to Harbottle in the County of Northumberland.

The speed restriction will be in force between the following hours:

- 21st September 2026 until the 10th October 2026 between the hours of 08:00 until 17:00.
- 16th November 2026 until the 18th November 2026 between the hours of 08:00 until 17:00.

This is to allow safe access for affected residents and properties whilst the works are ongoing.
