KIMMERSTON JUNCTION LOWICK

(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council intends to make an Order to prohibit the use by vehicular traffic on that section of the U1036 Fenton Junction to Kimmerston Junction Lowick from its junction with U1037 Fenton Mill Junction to Fenton Hill Junction heading in a southwards direction for a distance of 850 metres in the County of Northumberland. The Order is to be effective from the 14th October 2026 until the 23rd October 2026.

B6525 BERWICK ROAD TO DODDINGTON
