## (SPALDING – PENNYGATE AND WOOLRAM WYGATE) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) AMENDMENT ORDER 20

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce.

- No Waiting & No Loading on the north side of Pennygate in the vicinity of properties no's 25 - 29 Mon - Fri 8.30 - 9.30am and 2.30 - 4.30pm.
- No Waiting at Any Time at the junctions of Woolram Wygate, Pennygate Gardens and extend the existing No Waiting restrictions on Pennygate at its junction with Park Road.

**Exemptions** are included on the no waiting at any time which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.
