ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1) (SHORNCLIFFE ROAD)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable resurfacing works by FM Conway, it has made an order the effect of which is to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic from entering the above named road.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs are in place no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload on Shorncliffe Road, between Albany Road and Old Kent Road.
3. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
4. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
5. The road closure will be in place on the 27th and 28th of August 2026.
6. A signed diversion will be in place, the banned left turn from Albany Road onto Old Kent Road will be suspended.
7. This order remains valid for 18 months from the 13th of August 2026. Further information may be obtained by contacting Network Management at ttmo@southwark.gov.uk
