ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1) (PORTLAND STREET, WOOLER STREET)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable highway works by FM Conway, it intends to make an order, the effect of which is to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named roads.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs are in place no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload on
 - (a) Portland Street, at the junction of Wooler Street. From No's 156 to 168.
 - (b) Wooler Street, from the junction of Portland Street to number 1 Wooler Street.
3. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
4. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
5. The road closure will be in place between (a & b) 14th of September and 10th of October 2026.
6. This order remains valid for 18 months from the 3rd of September 2026. Further information may be obtained by contacting Road Network Management at tmo@southwark.gov.uk
