

LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1) (SOUTHWARK BRIDGE ROAD, UNION STREET)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable bridge maintenance works by Network Rail or it's appointed contractor, it has made an order, the effect of which is to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named roads.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs are in place no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload on
 - (a) Southwark Bridge Road, from the junction of Union Street to the junction of Southwark Street
 - (b) Union Street, at the junction with Southwark Bridge Road.
3. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
4. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
5. The road closure will be in place between the 22:00 on the 7th of September to 06:00 on the 8th of September and 22:00 on the 8th of September until 06:00 on the 9th of September 2026.
6. A signed diversion will be in place.
7. This order remains valid for 18 months from the 3rd of September 2026. Further information may be obtained by contacting Road Network Management at tmo@southwark.gov.uk
