THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A4189 WARWICK – HENLEY-IN-ARDEN – REDDITCH ROAD AND LYE GREEN ROAD, CLAVERDON) (30 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMITS) (VARIATION NO. 2) ORDER 2026; AND THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, DISTRICT OF STRATFORD ON AVON) (SPEED LIMIT) (A4189 CLAVERDON VARIATION NO. 3) ORDER 2026

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above-named Orders, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which would be to extend a 40 mph speed limit, replacing a section of existing 50 mph speed limit, on the A4189 Station Road, Claverdon. The proposed new extent of 40 mph speed limit is described in the Schedule below. The Order will commence on 1 June 2026.
