

# **SOLIHULL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL**

## **The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Hampton in Arden Village) (Total Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2025 (Amendment) Minor Order 2026**

The Council has made this Minor Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and other enabling powers. Details and reasons for the Order can be obtained from the address below, inspected at Solihull Connect, Library Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours, or viewed at <https://www.solihull.gov.uk/Roads-pavements-and-streetcare//Traffic-regulation-orders> Copies are available on request. Anyone wishing to challenge the validity of the Order may apply to the High Court within six weeks of it coming into force. The Order is administrative only and makes no changes to existing on-street restrictions. Effective from 17 July 2026, it amends Schedule One of The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Hampton in Arden Village) (Total Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2025 by deleting the following entry: No Waiting at Any Time – High Street (western side) – from Marsh Lane northwards for approximately 19 metres.

## **The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Dorsington Road, Solihull) (Footpath Closure) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026**

The Council gives notice that it has made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) to temporarily restrict pedestrian access to Dorsington Road Footpath (between Dorsington Road and Kineton Green Road) from 6 July to 31 July 2026 to allow Cadent Gas to carry out gas main works; a diversion via Kineton Green Road, Allesley Road and Mickleton Road will be in place (and vice versa), with emergency access and pedestrian access to properties maintained.
