S90A HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – ROAD HUMPS

Warwickshire County Council proposes to:

- vary The Warwickshire County Council (Welsh Road East, Southam) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2021 to reduce the 40mph speed limit to 30mph, by virtue of a system of streetlighting, on the length of road described in Schedule 1 below; and
- Install a road hump (raised table) on the length of road described in Schedule 2 below.

SCHEDULE 1

(Existing 40mph limit – proposed reduction to 30mph Speed Limit – by virtue of a system of street lighting)

1. Welsh Road East, Southam

From a point 157 metres south-east of its junction with Hodnell Drive, in a south-easterly direction along Welsh Road East for a distance of 85 metres

SCHEDULE 2

(Proposed S90 Road Humps/Raised table)

1. Welsh Road East/Dokata Drive, Southam

At the junction of Welsh Road East and Dakota Drive, Southam. The Road Hump/Raised table is proposed to 7.7metres wide x 9.2 metres long x 75mm in height, with an area of 70.84sqm
