The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Blossomfield Road, Solihull and adj Side Roads) (Road Closure) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026

The Council gives notice of its intention to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to enable highway improvement works. Restrictions will apply on sections of Blossomfield Road cycle lane between Tudor Grange Leisure Centre and Widney Lane, and at junctions with Dorchester Road, Alderbrook Road, White House Way, Kingslea Road, St Gerards Road and Charles Road, from 20 July 2026 to 18 September 2026, or until works are completed. Closures will be introduced in stages and only when signed.
