Order Commences: 3 August 2026 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 7 August 2026.

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL **(SERVICE ROAD ADJACENT TO THE A423** **BANBURY ROAD, SOUTHAM)** **(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026**

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above-named Order pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a 30 mph speed limit on the length of road mentioned in the Schedule below.

SCHEDULE

1. As yet unnamed Service Road (formerly part of the A423 Banbury Road, Southam opposite Starbold Farm)

From its junction with the A423 Banbury Road, northwards for its entire length, a distance of approximately 200 metres.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
