TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice of the proposal to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of an eastern part width of Farrier Close comprising of highway verge at Worcestershire, in the District of Bromsgrove.

If the order is made, the stopping up will be authorised only to enable development as permitted by Bromsgrove District Council under reference 26/00101/FUL.

Copies of the draft order and relevant plan will be available for inspection during normal opening hours at Bromsgrove District Council, Town Hall, Walter Stranz Square, Redditch Worcestershire, B98 8AH in the 28 days commencing on 17 July 2026, and may be obtained, free of charge, from the Secretary of State (quoting SUO7827346) at the address stated below.
