The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Dove House Lane, Solihull) (Road Closure) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026

The Council gives notice of its intention to make the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to allow structure testing and bridge joint replacement works on Dove House Lane at the bridge over the Grand Union Canal. The restriction will apply from 3 August 2026 to 28 August 2026 on behalf of Solihull MBC. A signed diversion will operate via Dove House Lane, Warwick Road, Seven Star Road and Lode Lane, and vice versa. Emergency service access through the closure cannot be provided. Pedestrian access to properties and through the closure will be maintained via defined routes throughout the works.
