The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Arden Road, Dorridge – Footpath SL48) (Footpath Closure) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026

The Council gives notice that it intends to make an Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), affecting Footpath SL48, from Arden Road, Dorridge to the field at the Borough Boundary – closed 24 hours a day from 10 August 2026 to 13 September 2026 to allow the replacement of a wooden boardwalk. A signed pedestrian diversion will be in place via the park, Grange Road and Windmill Lane. Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times, and where possible pedestrian access to properties and through the closure will be provided via defined routes. The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (A45 Coventry Road, Damson Parkway, and Terminal Road Birmingham Airport, Solihull) (Various Provisions) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026

The Council gives notice that it intends to make the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that all traffic should be restricted or prohibited to ensure that the following works can be undertaken in safety along A45 Coventry Road, Damson Parkway and Terminal Road (Birmingham Airport area) from 8 August 2026 to 7 February 2028 to facilitate junction upgrade works. The Order will include temporary 30mph speed limits, road closures, turn restrictions and access restrictions on sections of the A45, Damson Parkway and Terminal Road, with measures implemented as required for individual phases of the works. Restrictions will only apply when signed and full road closures will be limited to overnight or weekend periods. The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Dove House Lane, Solihull) (Road Closure) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026

The Council has made the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to allow structure testing and bridge joint replacement works on Dove House Lane at the bridge over the Grand Union Canal. The restriction will apply from 3 August 2026 to 28 August 2026 on behalf of Solihull MBC. A signed diversion will operate via Dove House Lane, Warwick Road, Seven Star Road and Lode Lane, and vice versa. Emergency service access through the closure cannot be provided. Pedestrian access to properties and through the closure will be maintained via defined routes throughout the works.
