TEMPORARY CLOSURE & NO WAITING NO STOPPING RESTRICTIONS

AT A444 JIMMY HILL WAY, COVENTRY

(MATCHES AT COVENTRY BUILDING SOCIETY ARENA)

Warwickshire County Council propose to make a Temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to close the A444 Jimmy Hill Way, Coventry, to vehicular traffic, between the County Boundary with Coventry and its roundabout junction with M6 Junction 3, and to impose no waiting and no stopping restrictions thereupon.

The temporary restrictions are required in the interests of public safety due to anticipated large crowds exiting from matches and other large capacity events held at the nearby Coventry Building Society Arena, and to assist with facilitating safe pedestrian egress therefrom.

The Order will commence on 29 August 2026 and will end on 31 July 2027. However, it is anticipated that the temporary restrictions will only be in operation during the dates specified in the Schedule below for football matches. Other large-capacity events may be held on dates not included in the Schedule, and the temporary restrictions will also be implemented in connection with such events. The dates shown are indicative only and may be subject to change in the event match dates or any other large capacity event is rescheduled.

An alternative route will be available for vehicular traffic via Pickards Way, Longford Road, Coventry Road, School Lane, Church Lane, Vicarage Lane, Ash Green Lane, Wheelwright Lane, Holbrook Lane, Holbrook Way, Jimmy Hill Way and vice versa. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times and exemptions will be applied for the emergency services.
