(CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION NO. 16) ORDER 2026

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the above-named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (Borough of Rugby) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places & Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017 (as varied) to introduce waiting restrictions on the lengths of roads as described in the Schedule below.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

(i) South-west side, from its junction with Bell Road north-westwards for a distance of 14 metres

(ii) North-east side, from its junction with Bell Road north-westwards for a distance of 9 metres

Parsons Close, Rugby

(i) North then east side, from its junction with Edison Drive, westwards then northwards for a distance of 64 metres

(ii) South then west side, from its junction with Edison Drive, westwards the northwards for a distance of 87 metres
