

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

LEICESTER ROAD & GIBBET HILL, CHURCHOVER

Order Effect: One-way traffic flow in a south westerly direction only will be imposed from A5 Gibbets Hill roundabout to Rugby Interchange. In addition, a temporary 40mph speed restriction will be in force from A5 Gibbets Hill roundabout to Lutterworth Road.

Reason for Order: To safely enable new utility supply works.

Order Commences: 25 August 2026 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 27 August 2026.
