On 17th August 2026 Wyre Forest District Council confirmed the above Order relating to the diversion of the public bridleway running from Point A to Point B as shown by a bold black line on the Order map to the alternative route between Point A to Point B and shown by bold black dashes on the Order map BEFORE the works required under Article 2 and 4 of the Order have been completed.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge at Wyre Forest House, Finepoint Way, Kidderminster, DY11 7WF from 9am to 5pm on Monday to Friday (save for public or bank holidays). Copies of the order and may be bought there at the price of £5.

This Order comes into force on, and the diversion does not come into effect until, the date on which the authority certifies that the terms of Article 2 of the Order have been complied with. A notice of coming into operation will be advertised.

If any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, they may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under Section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
