

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

D2183 MANOR DRIVE, STRETTON ON DUNSMORE

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Brookside.

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

A426 LEICESTER ROAD, RUGBY (SOUTHBOUND ONLY)

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between M6 Junction 1 roundabout and Tesco roundabout (Junction One Retail Park) excluding all roundabouts between these extents. In addition, a Temporary 30mph speed limit will be imposed on the southbound carriageway and the entirety of all roundabouts from M6 Junction 1 roundabout to and including Tesco Island.

Reason for Order: Closure to enable carriageway resurfacing and associated works, nightly 19.00hrs-05.00hrs. The 30-mph temporary speed limit is for the safety of all road users and of contractors whilst works are in progress. Works will be carried out in phases between the dates as indicated below.

(CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS,

ON STREET PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING)

(CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION NO. EV1) ORDER 2026

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (Borough of Rugby) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On-Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017, as described (by approximate measurements) in the Schedule below. The Order will commence on **7th September 2026**.

Exceptions to any waiting restrictions described in the Schedule below will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Electric Vehicles Only Pay & Display 2 Hours No Return 4 Hours Mon-Sat 8am-6pm

(i) from a point at the boundary between property number 41 and the FQ9550 footpath, northwards for 33 metres (6 no. bays)
