Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (District of Stratford-on-Avon) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On-Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017, as described (by approximate measurements) in the Schedule 1 below. The proposals described in Schedule 2 below have been withdrawn. The Order will commence on **7th September 2026**.

Exceptions to any waiting restrictions described in Schedule 1 below will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.
