The above Order made on **22 September 2026** if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by:

- Adding a section of Footpath, shown as a solid purple line on the plan reference SM230/DJL/Order Plan, starting at point A (grid reference SP 4175 5223) running in a generally north easterly direction along the fenced school boundary for approximately 142 metres to point B (grid reference SP 4185 5232).

The width of the route is 2 metres. Surface type: grassed and part tarmac.

If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in whole or in part, any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
