

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION
ACT 1984 - SECTIONS 14(1)(a) AND 7
THE A46 TRUNK ROAD (WARWICK,
WARWICKSHIRE) (TEMPORARY
PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited (Company no. 9346363) has made an order on the A46 Trunk Road in the County of Warwickshire, to allow bridge inspection work to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to close -

- (1) the exit slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A46 Warwick Bypass to its roundabout junction with the A425 and A4177 Birmingham Road, at Warwick; and
- (2) the layby adjacent to the southbound carriageway of the A46, approximately 100 metres northeast of the centreline of Wedgnock Lane overbridge, at Warwick.

The work will be carried out overnight between 20:00 hours and 06:00 hours and is expected to start on Friday 2 October 2026 and continue for one night. The Order will come into force on 25 September 2026.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes and vehicles being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closures.

A diversion route via an alternative junction of the A46 will be signed.
